### **Explanatory Note**

The Maintenance Orders (Enforcement) (Jersey) Law 1999 was adopted by the States in September 1998 (P176/98), and came into force on 22nd January 1999. Its effect was to expedite the procedure for the arrest of wages upon default in payment of the amount due under a maintenance order, either of the Family Division of the Royal Court or of the Petty Debts Court.

In the context of the Royal Court, the expression “maintenance order” was defined in the Law by reference to various Articles of the Matrimonial Causes (Jersey) Law 1949. Unfortunately, one such Article (*Article 25*) was overlooked, and the purpose of this draft Law is to rectify that omission.

**ARTICLE 1**
