At its meeting on 14th October 1999 the Tourism Committee considered the Proposition of Deputy P.F. Routier of St. Helier that Liberation Day be classed as a Sunday.

The Committee noted that there would be implications for certain of the Island's businesses and agreed that if the Proposition was successful it was essential that visitors be made aware of the circumstances, especially as, unlike a Sunday, Liberation Day could fall on any day of the week and change annually.

A formal Committee view was not recorded, and members agreed that individuals should be free to vote as they wished on this matter.
