## **REPORT**

On 6th July 2021, the Minister for Children and Education made a Ministerial Decision delegating certain of his functions under Articles 28, 30 and 30A of the <u>States of Jersey Law 2005</u> (see Decision reference MD-ESC-2021-0010., available at <u>www.gov.je</u>).

The terms of the delegations, and the legislation under which those delegations were made, were recorded in a Report attached to the Ministerial Decision, as shown below –

Functions delegated:	All powers and functions conferred upon or vested in him, including the power to make enactments and all other areas where the Minister has authority to act, to cover specific periods where the Minister is out of the Island or otherwise unavailable.

Delegate:	Deputy Trevor Pointon
Functions delegated:	All powers and functions conferred upon or vested in him, including the power to make enactments and all other areas where the Minister has authority to act, to cover specific periods where the Minister and the Assistant Minister Connétable Richard Vibert are both out of the Island or otherwise unavailable.  In addition, political oversight responsibility for:  Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services (CAMHS)
