REPORT

The fishery for ormers is due to be opened this autumn. This legislation provides greater security for the ormer stock by keeping this fishery closed while ormers are spawning in the months of May to September each year.

Financial and manpower implications

These Regulations have no additional financial or manpower implications for the resources of the States.

Explanatory Note

These Regulations amend the start of the period in each year during which ormers may be taken on certain days. The period will be the period between 30th September and the next 1st May. Previously the period was between 31st August and the next 1st May.

THE STATES, in pursuance of Articles 2, 8 and 22 of the Sea Fisheries (Jersey) Law 1994,^[1] having consulted with the Secretary of State and obtained the Secretary's concurrence, have made the following Regulations -

1. Regulation 4(3) of the Sea Fisheries (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Jersey) Regulations 1998^[2] shall be amended by substituting for sub-paragraph (a) the following sub-paragraph -

“(a) falls between 30th September and 1st May next; and”.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Sea Fisheries (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Regulations 200- and shall come into force on promulgation.
