The effect of this Order is to impose on a permanent basis the following one-way traffic requirements in Halkett Place –

- (a) between Beresford Street and Burrard Street, in the direction from Beresford Street towards Burrard Street; and
- (b) between Beresford Street and Hill Street, in the direction from Beresford Street towards Hill Street.

These replace temporary requirements which have now expired.
