Jersey Overseas Aid Commission: Re-Appointment of Non-States Commissioner

The Panel has noted the lodging of the Proposition Jersey Overseas Aid Commission: Re-Appointment of Non-States Commissioner [[P.18/2025](#)]. Although the Panel is not minded to question the specific re-appointment of Ms. Morel at this time, it would be beneficial if further explanation on the following points could please be provided:

- Confirmation as to whether an open recruitment of the non-States Commissioner position was advertised, and if this was not undertaken the reasoning behind not doing so?
- Clarification as to whether a Vice-Chair of the Commission has been agreed, and if so who has been acting in this role?
- Noting that two of the three non-States Commissioners tenures will reach the 9-year point following the completion of their current appointments, what succession planning is anticipated?
- Why no specific date is included within P.18/2025, with it only proposing that the re-appoint runs “for a three year period until April 2028”, if there is a specific date for the re-appointment to end and if you will look to amend the proposition to include this?

We would be grateful if you could respond no later than Monday 17th March 2025 in line with the 5 working days approved for responses between Scrutiny Panels and Ministers.
