A1. The Committee, with reference to its Minute No. A4 of 10th May 2011, received a draft comment in respect of the proposition 'Standing Orders: selection and appointment procedures,' lodged *au Greffe* on 14th April 2011 by Deputy M. Tadier of St. Brelade (P.61/2011 refers).

The Committee recalled that the proposition asked the States to agree to request the Privileges and Procedures Committee to review the selection and appointment procedures set out under Standing Orders. The Committee had been opposed the proposition on the basis that any such review should be carried out as part of a coherent examination of processes.
