REPORT

On 19 March 2024, the the Minister for Social Security made a Ministerial Decision delegating certain of her functions under Articles 28, 30 and 30A of the [States of Jersey Law 2005](#) (see Decision reference MD-SOSEC-2024-200, available at www.gov.je).

The terms of the delegations, and the legislation under which those delegations were made, were recorded in a Report attached to the Ministerial Decision, as shown below –

Delegate:	Deputy Sam Mézec
Functions delegated:	Assistant Minister for Social Security
Scope of delegation:	In the event that the Minister is unavailable or out of the Island, the Minister delegated all powers and functions conferred upon or vested in the Minister, including the powers to make an enactment, and all other areas where the Minister would otherwise have to act and be advised.
