Explanatory Note

These Regulations exempt from compulsory pilotage ships of less than one hundred tons gross tonnage engaged on a sail training voyage or a voyage under charter.

THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 2 of the Pilotage (Jersey) Law 1988,¹ have made the following Regulations -

1. In Regulation 17 of the Pilotage (General Provisions) (Jersey) Regulations 1988,² as amended³ -

- (a) for the full stop at the end of sub-paragraph (i) there shall be substituted a semi-colon; and
- (b) after sub-paragraph (i) there shall be inserted the following sub-paragraph -

“(j) ships of less than one hundred tons gross tonnage engaged on a sail training voyage or a voyage under charter.”.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Pilotage (General Provisions) (Amendment No. 7) (Jersey) Regulations 199 and shall come into force on the first day of January 1999.
