## DRAFT FREEDOM OF INFORMATION (JERSEY) LAW 2011 (APPOINTED DAY) ACT 201-

#### **REPORT**

This Act will bring into force the Freedom of Information (Jersey) Law 2011 on 1st January 2015. The Chief Minister has been committed to bringing into force the Freedom of Information legislation in January 2015. The States Assembly made a commitment in response to P.41/2011 to bring in the legislation by the end of 2015: not only has that commitment been fulfilled, but the legislation is being brought into force a year ahead of schedule.

#### Financial and manpower implications

The potential resource implications of the Freedom of Information (Jersey) Law 2011 overall have been well rehearsed in earlier reports to the States Assembly. The actual resource implications of the FOI Law will depend upon the number of requests handled and the quality of information management. There are no other financial or manpower implications for the States arising from the adoption of this Appointed Day Act.
