Explanatory Note

These Regulations would widen the definition “speed boat” to include any mechanically propelled vessel under 30 feet that is designed to travel faster than 12 knots, whether or not it is capable of doing so.

The Regulations, if made, will come into force on 1st February 2002.

These draft Regulations have no implications for the financial or manpower resources of the States.

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Article 4 of the Harbours (Administration) (Jersey) Law 1961,^[1] as amended,^[2] have made the following Regulations -

1. In Regulation 26(1) of the Boats and Surf-Riding (Control) (Jersey) Regulations 1969, as amended,^[3] for the definition “speed boat” there shall be substituted the following definition -

“ ‘speed boat’ means a vessel which -

- (a) is mechanically propelled;
- (b) is under thirty feet in overall length; and
- (c) is designed for or capable of travelling on the sea at a speed in excess of twelve knots,

except a boat which is registered under Part I of the Merchant Shipping Act, 1894 (57 & 58 Vict. c. 60) or under corresponding legislation of any foreign country.”.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Boats and Surf-Riding (Control) (Amendment No. 22) (Jersey) Regulations 200- and shall come into force on the first day of February 2002.
