Draft States of Jersey (Miscellaneous Provisions) Law 201-: request to Privy Council' (P.99/2011): draft comment. 450/1(16)

A1. The Committee, with reference to its Minute No. A1 of 2nd March 2011, recalled that on 3rd March 2011 the States had rejected a proposition of the Deputy of Grouville to refer to their Act dated 20th January 2011 in which, subject to the sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, they adopted a Law entitled the States of Jersey (Miscellaneous Provisions) Law 201-, and, amongst other things, to agree that it was no longer the wish of the Assembly that the Law should receive the sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council. It further recalled that on 6th June 2011 the Deputy of Grouville had lodged '*au Greffe*' an essentially identical proposition entitled: 'Draft States of Jersey (Miscellaneous Provisions) Law 201-: request to Privy Council' (P.99/2011 refers).

The Committee considered a draft comment to Projet No. P.99/2011.
