These Regulations prescribe the fees for the grant or renewal of licences under the Licensing (Jersey) Law 1974.

The effect is to increase all licensing fees by approximately 2.5%. The fees were last increased in September 2001.

**THE STATES,** in pursuance of Article 11 of the Licensing (Jersey) Law 1974, as amended, have made the following Regulations -

1.-(1) Subject to paragraphs (2), (3), (4) and (5) of this Regulation, the fees payable on the grant or renewal o licences shall be as follows -

First Category

("Taverner's Licence")

£383 plus a fee of 94p multiplied by the maximum number of persons who may at any time be accommodated for reward on the premises (in these Regulations referred to as "the number of approved

residents")

Second Category ("Residential Licence")

A fee of 94p multiplied by the number of approved residents, with a minimum fee

of £119

Third Category

("Restaurant Licence")

£383

Fourth Category £955 plus a fee of £1.90 multiplied by

("Comprehensive Licence") the number of approved residents

Fifth Category £286 ("Club Licence")

Sixth Category ("Off-Licence")

£99

Seventh Category

("Entertainment Licence")

(a) cinemas, theatres £383

(b) places of entertainment other than cinemas and theatres A fee of 94p multiplied by the number of persons mentioned in the permit for entertainment granted by the Bailiff in respect of the premises, with a minimum

fee of £383.

- (2) Where licences of different categories are applicable to the same premises, a separate fee shall be payable in respect of each category of licence.
- (3) Where a licence will expire within 6 months of its commencement, the fee for the licence shall be one half of that prescribed in paragraph (1) of this Regulation.
- (4) Where a licence will expire more than 12 months and 7 days after its commencement, the fee for the licenc shall be increased by one-twelfth.
- (5) Where an application for grant of a licence is refused or withdrawn, the amount of the fee shall be refunded to the applicant.
  - 2. The Licensing (Licence Fees) (Jersey) Regulations 2001<sup>[2]</sup> shall be repealed.
- **3.** These Regulations may be cited as the Licensing (Licence Fees) (Jersey) Regulations 200- and shall come into force on the day following promulgation.
