Report

The report accompanying these draft Regulations covers three sets of draft Regulations and is printed in P.72/2002 (Draft Gambling (Betting) (Amendment No. 13) (Jersey) Regulations 2000).

Explanatory Note

The draft Regulations amend the Gambling (Licensing Provisions) (Jersey) Regulations 1965 by revising the wording of the activities permitted by betting office and credit betting office licences. The original wording authorized all betting transactions other than pool betting transactions, which are not permitted to be arranged on such premises. It is proposed that it should be permissible for Tote betting transactions to be transacted from such premises. As Tote betting falls within the definition of pool betting, but is not authorized under the Pool Betting Regulations, it would be necessary to specify the prohibited form of pool betting more precisely in order to allow what is proposed.

THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 3 of the Gambling (Jersey) Law 1964,^[1] as amended, have made the following Regulations -

1. In the Second Schedule to the Gambling (Licensing Provisions) (Jersey) Regulations 1965, as amended,^[2] in the forms of betting office licence and credit betting office licence, for the words “for the purpose of effecting betting transactions, other than pool betting transactions” there shall be substituted “for the purpose of effecting lawful betting transactions, other than pool betting transactions authorized under the Gambling (Pool Betting) (Jersey) Regulations, 1965”.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Gambling (Licensing Provisions) (Amendment No. 13) (Jersey) Regulations 200- and shall come into force on the day following promulgation.
