### **Explanatory Note**

The purpose of this Law is to amend the Agricultural Marketing (Jersey) Law 1953 to lower certain minimum requirements that a marketing scheme under that Law must impose. Those requirements relate to the total number of members of a marketing board, the quorum for such a board and the minimum size of such a board's executive committee.

At the same time, an old-style provision relating to the publication of notices is updated to expressly require their publication in the Jersey Gazette.

THE STATES, subject to the sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, have adopted the following Law -

#### ARTICLE 1

The Agricultural Marketing (Jersey) Law 1953, as amended, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law") is amended in paragraph (1) of Article 3 -

- (a) by substituting for sub-paragraph (a) the following sub-paragraph -
  - "(a) the total number of members of the board shall be no fewer than eight and no more than twenty;"
- (b) by substituting for sub-paragraph (d) the following sub-paragraph -

"(d) the quorum of the board shall be no less than half of its total membership."

#### ARTICLE 2

The principal Law is amended in paragraph (5) of Article 3 by substituting for the words "five members" the words "four or five persons (as the scheme provides)".

#### ARTICLE 3

The principal Law is amended by substituting for Article 20 the following Article -

#### "ARTICLE 20.

#### PUBLICATION OF NOTICES.

A notice required to be published under this Law shall be published in the Jersey Gazette."

#### ARTICLE 4

This Law may be cited as the Agricultural Marketing (Amendment No. 6) (Jersey) Law 199 .
