**Explanatory Note**

These Regulations suspend the effect of Regulation 4 of the Sea Fisheries (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Jersey) Regulations 1998 in so far as it permits people to fish for ormers on “permitted days”, as defined in the Regulation.

**THE STATES**, in pursuance of Articles 2, 5, 8 and 22 of the Sea Fisheries (Jersey) Law 1994,<sup>1</sup> having consulted with the Secretary of State and obtained his concurrence, have made the following Regulations -

1. Notwithstanding Regulation 4 of the Sea Fisheries (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Jersey) Regulations 1998,<sup>2</sup> a person shall not -

- (a) fish for or take ormers (*Haliotis tuberculata*);
- (b) retain fresh ormers in his possession; or
- (c) export fresh ormers from the Island,

except in the circumstances specified in paragraph (2) of that Regulation.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Sea Fisheries (Ormers - Temporary Restrictions) (Jersey) Regulations 1999 and shall come into force on the seventh day following promulgation.
