## **Explanatory Note**

These Regulations suspend the effect of Regulation 4 of the Sea Fisheries (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Jersey) Regulations 1998 in so far as it permits people to fish for ormers on "permitted days", as defined in the Regulation.

THE STATES, in pursuance of Articles 2, 5, 8 and 22 of the Sea Fisheries (Jersey) Law 1994, having consulted with the Secretary of State and obtained his concurrence, have made the following Regulations -

- 1. Notwithstanding Regulation 4 of the Sea Fisheries (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Jersey) Regulations 1998,<sup>2</sup> a person shall not -
  - (a) fish for or take ormers (Haliotis tuberculata);
  - (b) retain fresh ormers in his possession; or
  - (c) export fresh ormers from the Island,

except in the circumstances specified in paragraph (2) of that Regulation.

These Regulations may be cited as the Sea Fisheries (Ormers - Temporary Restrictions) (Jersey) Regulations 1999 and shall come into force on the seventh day following promulgation.
