Delegate:	Connétable Richard Vibert
Functions delegated:	All powers and functions conferred upon or vested in her, including the power to make enactments and all other areas where the Minister has authority to act, to cover specific periods where the Minister and the Assistant Minister Deputy Louise Doublet are both out of the Island or otherwise unavailable.
