A1. The Committee, with reference to its Minute No. B1 of 25th July 2017, recalled that it was due to hear from Deputy A.D. Lewis of St. Helier on 1st August 2017 in relation to the findings of the Independent Jersey Care Inquiry that he had ‘lied’ both to the States and to the Inquiry.
