A4. The Sub-Committee noted the correspondence received from the Chief Minister and the updated recommendations. It was noted that the Chief Minister had stated that due to limited time the current Government had in office, it would not be possible to bring reform of constitutional arrangements or significant organisational change as the focus was on service delivery. The Sub-Committee agreed that it was content with the additions to the recommendations and would write to the President of the Scrutiny Liaison Committee to ask for its views on taking the matter forward.

Standing Orders 113/115 regarding timings around appointing a A5. The Sub-Committee discussed an amendment to Standing Order 113/115 regarding timings around appointment of a new Chief Minister as the recent VONC revealed the short turnaround time in which the Assembly had to appoint a new Chief Minister. It was agreed that office continuity must be a priority and it was requested that a timetable of VONC and how things happened be presented for further consideration.
