The Panel, with the Greffier of the States in attendance, noted the provisions of Standing Order 5 in respect of additional meetings of the States Assembly. | |

Ozouf, Minister for Treasury and Resources, confirmation of the timetable for borrowing in respect of the Housing Project in order that clarification could be provided of the implications of not recommencing the debate on P.133/2013 until 21st January 2014. It was also agreed to request confirmation of whether the Council of Ministers would seek a special sitting of the Assembly.
