## REPORT

---

On the 28th January 2020, the States Assembly adopted [P.9/2020](#) (Public Holidays: designation of 27th September 2021 – commemoration of the Corn Riots and the Code of 1771).

Under this proposition, the Assembly declared that they were of the opinion that Monday 27th September 2021 should be designated as an extra Public and Bank Holiday and requested the Chief Minister to bring forward the necessary Act under the Public Holidays and Bank Holidays (Jersey) Law 1951 to give effect to the decision.

This Act has been duly lodged in compliance with the wishes of the States Assembly as expressed in P.9/2020. If approved, the Act would amend Part 2 of the Schedule to the Public Holidays and Bank Holidays (Jersey) Law 1951 to make provision for Monday 27th September 2021 to be observed as a one-off public holiday in recognition of the 250th anniversary of the Code of 1771.

### **Financial and manpower implications**

In terms of the Government and non-Ministerial departments, the cost of paying staff who would have otherwise worked is estimated as £1.38 million. This is not an additional cost to the Government. However, it does reflect the cost of a day's lost work. That work would either have to be covered by overtime payments, not done or added to the employees' workload for when they return to work.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

---

This Act, if passed, would amend Part 2 of the Schedule to the Public Holidays and Bank Holidays (Jersey) Act 2010 to make provision for Monday 27th September 2021 to be observed as a public holiday, in recognition of the 250th anniversary of the Code of 1771, and to remove a reference to an obsolete public holiday.

**THE STATES** make this Act under Article 2 of the Public Holidays and Bank Holidays (Jersey) Law 1951<sup>1</sup> –

### **1 Public Holidays and Bank Holidays (Jersey) Act 2010 amended**

For the text in Part 2 of the Schedule to the Public Holidays and Bank Holidays (Jersey) Act 2010<sup>2</sup> there is substituted –

#### **“2021: 250th Anniversary of the Code of 1771**

Monday 27th September 2021 is to be observed as a public holiday.”.

### **2 Citation and commencement**

This Act may be cited as the Public Holidays and Bank Holidays (Amendment No. 3) (Jersey) Act 202- and comes into force 7 days after it is made.
