A1. The Committee, with reference to its Minute No. B1 of 23rd January 2008, considered draft comments, prepared by the Committee Clerk, concerning the draft Public Elections (Amendment No.3) (Jersey) Law 200- (P.2/2008 refers) and the draft Public Elections (Amendment No.3) (Jersey) Law 200-: Amendment (P.2/2008 Amd. refers).

The Committee concluded that the draft comments encapsulated its views on both the proposition and the amendment; however, it considered that States members might wish to be reminded of the position in a number of other jurisdictions regarding entitlement to vote. To that end it was agreed that the draft comment concerning the principal proposition should be amended to include the appendix which had been presented to the Assembly in 2007 as part of the Committee's comment to the proposition entitled, 'Electoral Registration: Link to Population Register' (P.68/2007 refers).

The Committee approved the comment to the draft Public Elections (Amendment No.3) (Jersey) Law 200- (P.2/2008 refers), as amended, and the comment to the draft Public Elections (Amendment No.3) (Jersey) Law 200-: Amendment (P.2/2008 Amd. refers).
