It was subsequently noted that consideration could also be given to the pertinence of the legal aspects surrounding that Agreement. The Sub-Panel further noted, however, that due consideration would need to be given to the Code of Practice for Scrutiny Panels and the Public Accounts Committee when requesting any such information.
