PAGE 9, ARTICLE 1(2) –

In the inserted Article 2B –

- (a) in paragraph (1)(b) delete the words “, if the condition in paragraph (2) is satisfied”;
- (b) in paragraph (1)(c) delete the words “, if the condition in paragraph (3) is satisfied”;
- (c) delete paragraphs (2) and (3);
- (d) renumber paragraph (4) as paragraph (2).

REPORT

This amendment is consequential to my amendment to the MTFP. At present, the transfer of funds from the Health Insurance Fund (HIF) is contingent on the separate health charge being accepted by the Assembly. This removes that contingency and allows the sums required to be sourced from changes to the Social Security contribution rates.
