Explanatory Note regarding subordinate legislation tabled at this meeting.

R&O.40/2016.

This Order increases the limits on expenses that may be charged to a third-party motor insurer in relation to treatment of a victim of a road traffic accident occurring on or after 1st April 2016. The new limits are identical to those applying under the NHS Injury Costs Recovery Scheme (the equivalent third-party insurance scheme in the United Kingdom) with effect from the same date.

The Order was made on 11th April 2016 and came into force on being made.
