

09/03/11 Item 6 513/27(8)	<p>1. Comprehensive Spending Review: 2012 – 2013 and Delivery</p> <p>The Panel agreed to appoint Mr N. McLocklin of Capita Symonds and Mr. M.J Oliver, as its expert advisors for its second Comprehensive Spending Review. It requested that contracts were drafted in order to formalise arrangements.</p> <p>The Panel discussed the way forward with the review and agreed to invite all Ministers for Public Hearings. It was agreed that the Hearings would last approximately one hour for each Minister, except the Hearings with the Chief Minister and Minister for Treasury and Resources, in which more time would be allocated.</p> <p>The Panel recalled its decision to hold a Public Hearing with Mr J. Seddon of Vanguard. It was explained that Mr Seddon's Personal Assistant had been contacted and would offer available dates in Mr Seddon's calendar pending the Panel's discussion. It was agreed that the Panel would make itself available on the dates Mr Seddon was able to do. It noted that possible dates would be circulated electronically.</p> <p>The Panel noted that the Health, Social Security and Housing Scrutiny Panel had also planned to undertake a review into the second phase of the Comprehensive Spending Review. It agreed that the Panel would be contacted to inform it of the Panel's intentions to hold Public Hearings with the Health and Social Services Minister, Social Security Minister and Housing Minister.</p> <p>The Panel noted that it had discussed inserting an additional term of reference for its review, to incorporate the Comprehensive Spending Review's main objectives. It received the revised terms of reference and agreed that a letter should be drafted to the Chief Minister and Minister for Treasury and Resources to inform them of the change. It also agreed that the revised terms of reference would be sent to the Chairmen's Committee.</p> <p>The Panel was advised that the Delivery Plan for the Comprehensive Spending Review was being printed and would be sent to the Scrutiny Office on Monday 21st March 2011.
