# DRAFT MEDICINES (AMENDMENT No. 2) (JERSEY) LAW 2005 (APPOINTED DAY) ACT 200

#### **REPORT**

This Act brings into force the Medicines (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Law 2005 with effect from 1st December 2005. The Law, which was adopted by the States on 1st February 2005, restores the ability for Jersey to differ to the UK regarding the legal classification of a medicine where it is considered desirable to do so. The legal classification of a medicine determines how it may lawfully be supplied and the ability to differ to the UK was lost following changes in the way the UK places medicines in a particular legal category. The Law restores this ability to differ.

There are no financial or manpower implications for the States arising from this draft Act.

## **Explanatory Note**

This Act brings into force the Medicines (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Law 2005 with effect from 1st December 2005. The Law was adopted by the States on 1st February 2005 (P.214/2004). It treats any condition of supply to which a medicinal product is subject by virtue of the terms of its marketing authorization as if it were a condition prescribed by Order unless an Order otherwise provides.

### 1 Commencement of Medicines (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Law 2005

The Medicines (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Law 2005 shall come into force on 1st December 2005.

This Act may be cited as the Medicines (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Law 2005 (Appointed Day) Act 200.
