## **REPORT**

On 19 March 2024, the the Minister for External Relations made a Ministerial Decision delegating certain of his functions under Articles 28, 30 and 30A of the <u>States of Jersey Law 2005</u> (see Decision reference MD-ER-2024-211, available at <u>www.gov.je</u>).

matters. The delegation will also include the ability to lodge propositions in the name of the Minister, and present reports or comments to the States in the name of the Minister.
