·	That the figures produced by Dr. Evans and the Statistics Unit should provide a basis for understanding trends and some comparative data that can be validated against future reviews;	
	That one approach which might be taken to engage with 'seldom heard' groups would be to contact charities and organizations to assist with undertaking 'workshops' using a questionnaire format to build a picture of where the financial difficulties and deprivations are being felt.
