Explanatory Note

The purpose of this Law is to authorize the making and levying of rates in the parishes for the year 2003.

THE STATES, subject to the sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, have adopted the following Law -

ARTICLE 1

A foncier rate and an occupier's rate are hereby authorized to be made and levied in the parishes of the Island for the year 2003, in accordance with the Parish Rate (Administration) (Jersey) Law 1946, as amended. ^[1]

ARTICLE 2

This Law may be cited as the Parish Rate (Jersey) Law 200-, and shall come into force on the seventh day following its registration.
