#### **REPORT**

**Decision(s):** Under Standing Order 168(3) the Minister for Treasury and Resources hereby notifies the States that he has accepted the recommendation of the Property Holdings Department to agree to the following –

#### (a) Land transaction –

To appoint Dandara Jersey Lettings to provide a full letting and management service in respect of Flats 2, 4, 5, 6 and 15, Fourteen Gloucester Street, St. Helier, the individual lettings to be approved under delegated authority by the Director or Assistant Director of Jersey Property Holdings.

The Minister hereby authorises the Director of Property Holdings to pass any contract which is required to be passed on behalf of the Public.

After the expiry of 15 days following presentation to the States the transaction may be concluded.
