Draft Shops (Regulation of Opening and Deliveries) (Jersey) Law 2010 (Appointed Day) Act 201-P.96/2011

THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 12 of the Shops (Regulation of Opening and Deliveries) (Jersey) Law 2010, made an Act entitled the Shops (Regulation of Opening and Deliveries) (Jersey) Law 2010 (Appointed Day) Act 2011.
