PROPOSITION

THE STATES are asked to decide whether they are of opinion –

to refer to their Act dated 7th July 2004 in which they agreed that the composition of the Shadow Public Accounts Committee should be amended to include 2 additional States members, not being Presidents of Committees or members of the Finance and Economics Committee or Privileges and Procedures Committee, with the additional members being appointed by the States on the nomination of the Shadow Chairman of the Committee, and –
