Most meaningful statistics with any credibility are gathered on a frequent enough basis to show appropriate trends on which policy and decisions can be based and amended when necessary.

The removal of the collection for the quarters ending March and September will, I believe, question the credibility of keeping and recording these statistics, especially where there could (or should) be seasonal trends - for example - Tourism!

The continuation of the gathering and publication of relevant employment statistics is a vital informative part of the process of good governance.

There are no additional financial or manpower implications arising out of this proposition as, if adopted, the current system of collecting quarterly statistics would continue.
