Budget 1984 – continued.

THE STATES continued their discussion of the Budget for the financial year commencing 1st January, 1984 and continued consideration of the estimates of Capital Expenditure recommended by the Finance and Economics Committee on pages 62, 63 and 64 of the Budget and –

The estimate of the capital expenditure of the Public Works Committee appearing on page 62 of the Budget was allowed.

The estimate of the capital expenditure of the Education Committee appearing on page 62 of the Budget was allowed.

The estimate of the capital expenditure of the Public Health Committee appearing on page 62 of the Budget was allowed.

The estimate of the capital expenditure of the Resources Recovery Board appearing on page 63 of the Budget was allowed.

The estimate of the capital expenditure of the Tourism Committee appearing on page 63 of the Budget was allowed.

The estimate of the capital expenditure of the Island Development Committee appearing on page 63 of the Budget was allowed.

THE STATES adopted in Second Reading a Bill to continue certain expiring fiscal laws; to prescribe the standard rate of income tax for the year nineteen hundred and eighty-four; and to amend the law relating to income tax in relation to certain savings banks and personal allowances and reliefs.

The said Bill was lodged "au Greffe".

THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 25 of the Public Finances (Administration) (Jersey) Law, 1967, have declared that the Bill to continue certain expiring fiscal laws; to prescribe the standard rate of income tax for the year nineteen hundred and eighty-four; and to amend the law relating to income tax in relation to certain savings banks and personal allowances and reliefs (which has this day been lodged "au Greffe") shall immediately have effect as if it were a law passed by the States and sanctioned by Her Majesty in Council.
