Energy Efficiency Review</b> The Panel, having interviewed three candidates for the position of adviser for the above review, decided to defer the appointment pending further refinement of the scope for the next stage of the review.  The Panel considered the following suggested ways forward: (a) targeted call for evidence of ways in which the States could improve energy efficiency in its buildings (b) further discussions with departmental officers to ensure that the Panel's work complemented the ongoing review led by the Deputy Chief Executive and awareness campaign planned by the Planning and Environment (c) research covering Scrutiny reviews on energy efficiency undertaken in local authorities in the UK. (d) enquiries about appropriate consultancy support from national organisations such as the Carbon Trust, the Department of Energy and Climate Change and the Energy Saving Trust. (e) energy audits undertaken at specific office locations as a means of exemplifying energy savings possibilities (f) commissioning a benchmarking exercise to compare the energy performance of the States of Jersey as a whole with a small section of other comparable public sector organisations.  The Panel requested officers to review the scoping document and to prepare a plan for the next stage of the review.	MH/MO
