513/18(8)	<p>4. Edge Analytics Invoice</p> <p>The Sub-Panel noted and agreed that the invoice from Edge Analytics would be paid for work carried out in November 2009.</p>

Future Work (Migration)</p> <p>The Sub-Panel was advised that the Corporate Services Scrutiny Panel had agreed to undertake a review in relation to Data Protection, and that there would not be the resources to carry out the Migration review at the same time. The Panel had subsequently agreed that Data Protection would take priority over Migration. The Sub-Panel agreed that Public Hearings would therefore commence in March/April 2010 after the Data Protection review had been completed.</p> <p>The Scrutiny Officer was requested to correspond with the Population Office to find out whether its Migration Policy would be debated in June or had been deferred until July 2010.</p>	KB

	The Sub-Panel explored lines of enquiry which it might want to take and agreed three main areas within the legislation to review, namely registration cards, population register and housing and employment qualifications.
