REPORT

On 6th February 2024, the Minister for Health and Social Services made a Ministerial Decision delegating certain of his functions under Articles 28, 30 and 30A of the [States of Jersey Law 2005](#) (see Decision reference MD-HSS-2024-55, available at www.gov.je).

Functions delegated:	Assistant Minister for Health and Social Services
Scope of delegation:	In the event that the Minister is unavailable or out of the Island, the Minister delegated all powers and functions conferred upon or vested in the Minister, including the power to make an enactment, and all other areas where the Minister would otherwise have to act and be advised.

Delegate:	Deputy Barbara Ward of St Clement
Functions delegated:	Assistant Minister for Health and Social Services
Scope of delegation:	In the event that the Minister is unavailable or out of the Island, the Minister delegated all powers and functions conferred upon or vested in the Minister, including the power to make an enactment, and all other areas where the Minister would otherwise have to act and be advised.
