**Question**

Will the Minister advise what percentage of the healthcare budget expenditure was for Long-Term Incapacity Allowance in 2021?

**Answer**

Long Term Incapacity Allowance (LTIA) is a contributory benefit paid from the Social Security Fund. Therefore, 0% percent of the healthcare budget expenditure was for Long-Term Incapacity Allowance in 2021.

In 2021, LTIA benefit expenditure amounted to £22m. The total expenditure in 2021 in relation to benefits payable from the Social Security Fund was £261m.
