#### **Explanatory Note**

These Regulations amend the Policing of Parks (Jersey) Regulations so as to bring them into line with amendments to be made to the Road Traffic Law in relation to cycle tracks, pedal cycles and wheelchairs in the Road Traffic (Amendment No. 49) (Jersey) Regulations 199 (P.169/98) and the repeal of the Road Transport Lighting (Jersey) Law 1956.

The Regulations come into force on 1st November 1998, the same day as P.169/98, save for the Regulation deleting the reference to the Road Transport Lighting Law which comes into force on 1st January 1999 when the repeal of that Law is to take effect.

**THE STATES,** in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by the Order in Council of the twenty-sixth day of December 1851, Article 49 of the Road Traffic (Jersey) Law 1956, as amended, and the Policing of Roads, Parks and Sea Beaches (Application of Fines) (Jersey) Law 1957, as amended, have made the following Regulations -

- 1. In Regulation 1 of the Policing of Parks (Jersey) Regulations 1962, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations") -
  - (a) for the definition of "motor vehicle" there shall be substituted the following definitions -
    - " 'cycle track', 'motor vehicle', 'pedal cycle' and 'wheelchair' have the meanings assigned to them in the Road Traffic (Jersey) Law 1956, as amended"; and
  - (b) the definitions of "pedal cycle" and "quadcycle" shall be deleted.
- **2.** For sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph (1) of Regulation 3 of the principal Regulations there shall be substituted the following sub-paragraph -

- "(b) use any vehicle, except -
  - (i) a wheelchair, toy cycle, scooter or perambulator;
  - (ii) a motor vehicle being driven on a road in the park, or any part of the park reserved by the park authority for the parking of such vehicles or as a means of access to that part;
  - (iii) a pedal cycle being ridden on a road or cycle track in the park; or
  - (iv) a road train being driven on a road train track established under Regulation 4B of these Regulations;".
- 3. In Regulation 4A of the principal Regulations -
- (a) for paragraph (2) there shall be substituted the following paragraph -
  - "(2) Articles 14, 14B, 15, 16, 16F, 18, 24, 25, 26, 27 and 36 of the Road Traffic (Jersey) Law 1956, as amended, shall apply to the riding of pedal cycles on cycle tracks established under this Regulation; and
- (b) paragraph (3) shall be repealed.
- **4.** Paragraph (7) of Regulation 4B of the principal Regulations shall be repealed.
- **5.-**(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Policing of Parks (Amendment No. 13) (Jersey) Regulations 1998.
- (2) Subject to paragraph (3) of this Regulation, these Regulations shall come into force on the first day of November 1998.
- (3) Paragraph (b) of Regulation 3 and Regulation 4 of these Regulations shall come into force on the first day of January 1999.
