### Explanatory Note regarding subordinate legislation tabled at this meeting.

#### R&O 91/2007

The object of this Order is to implement some of the documentation and notice requirements of Council Regulation (EEC) No. 3677/90 of 13 December 1990. The requirements relate to the import, export and transit of substances that are specified in Schedule 5 of the Misuse of Drugs (Jersey) Law 1978. They are substances that may be used in the manufacture of certain narcotic or psychotropic substances.

Article 7(4) of the Misuse of Drugs Law (Jersey) Law 1978 sets out the offence, and the penalty, that apply if the Order is not complied with.

Article 1 sets out a number of definitions used in the Order.

Article 2 requires invoices and freight documents to set out certain details of scheduled substances.

Article 3 requires consignments of scheduled substances to be labelled with the names of the substances.

Article 4 requires details of imports into Jersey, exports from Jersey and transits through Jersey of scheduled substances to be recorded. The records are to be kept for at least 3 years.

Article 5 requires Jersey-based arrangements for the movement of scheduled substances from one country to another to be recorded and the records to be kept for at least 3 years.

Article 6 requires someone who wants to export a scheduled substance to give the Chief Pharmacist in Jersey notice of the export at least 14 days before the export takes place.

Article 7 allows a civil servant under the administration of the Minister for Health and Social Services, a police officer or a customs officer to inspect and copy the documents to which this Order applies.

Article 8 sets out the name of the Order and says when it is to come into force.

The Order was made on 12th July 2007 and comes into force on 19th July 2007.

#### R&O 92/2007

This Order adds to the list of proscribed organizations in Schedule 1 to the Terrorism (Jersey) Law 2002.

The Order was made on 17th July 2007 and comes into force on 18th July 2007.
