A1. The Committee, with reference to its Act No. A5 of 9th January 2004, received a draft amendment to the Code of Practice on Public Access to Official Information: Register of reports (P.196/2003).

The Committee recalled that it had agreed that the deadline proposed by Deputy P.N. Troy in his proposition, namely that a register of reports should be in place '*with effect from 1st March 2004*', was unrealistic, approved the draft amendment, together with the accompanying report on the basis that three months from the date the proposition was accepted was a more realistic target.
