REPORT

The Draft Animal Health (Jersey) Law 201- (P.17/2016) was approved by the States Assembly on 12th April 2016. When the Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016 is enacted, it will repeal 4 Laws which are no longer fit for purpose.

The following Laws are repealed -

- Fertilisers and Feeding Stuffs (Jersey) Law 1950;
- Artificial Insemination of Domestic Animals (Jersey) Law 1952;
- Diseases of Animals (Jersey) Law 1956;
- Diseases of Animals (Rabies) (Jersey) Law 1976.

Conclusion

The Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016 provides the necessary changes to the legal framework in animal health for the future.

Financial and manpower implications

The financial and manpower implications are as described in the report within P.17/2016, which also describes in detail the purpose and functions of the Law when it is brought into force.



Explanatory Note

This Act brings the Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016 into force on 1st February 2017 (apart from a few minor amendments which came in when the Law was registered).
