On 6th January 1999, the Jersey Transport Authority made an Act, delegating certain of its functions under Article 13 of the Air Transport Permits (Jersey) Law 1998.

The terms of the delegation were recorded in an Act of the Authority as follows -

“The Authority, in pursuance of Article 36A of the States of Jersey Law 1966, as amended, decided, with immediate effect, to delegate to the Airport Director its functions under Article 13 of the Air Transport Permits (Jersey) Law 1998 as follows -

Legislation: Air Transport Permits (Jersey) Law
1998

Delegate: Airport Director

**Functions
delegated:** The power to prevent unauthorised
flights by either giving a direction to
the person appearing to be in
command of the aircraft to be used

that he shall not permit the aircraft to take off, or by detaining the aircraft until he is satisfied that the aircraft will not be so used.

The Greffier of the States was requested to arrange for this Act to be presented to the States for information in due course.”.

On 20th January 1999, the Jersey Transport Authority made an Act, delegating certain of its functions under Articles 6 and 8 of the Air Transport Permits (Jersey) Law 1998.

The terms of the delegation were recorded in an Act of the Authority as follows -

“The Authority, in pursuance of Article 36A of the States of Jersey Law 1966, as amended, decided to delegate to the Executive Officer its functions under Articles 6 and 8 of the Air Transport Permits (Jersey) Law 1998, as follows

Legislation:	Air Transport Permits (Jersey) Law 1998
Delegate:	Executive Officer, Jersey Transport Authority or, in his absence, Mr. G.C. Powell, OBE, Consultant.
Function delegated:	The Authority to grant, vary, suspend or revoke permits.
Scope of delegation:	<p>To grant or vary a permit upon the terms proposed in the application, upon terms other than those proposed in the application or to refuse to grant a permit.</p> <p>To suspend a permit at any time when a suspension of the air transport licence, route licence or permission of the Secretary of State which also authorises the flights to which the permit relates is in effect.</p> <p>To revoke a permit if a revocation of the air transport licence, route licence or permission of the Secretary of State which also authorises the flights to which the permit relates takes effect.</p> <p>To vary, suspend or revoke a permit other than on application by the permit holder pursuant to Articles 3 or 7, as the case may be.</p>

The Authority decided that the delegation would have effect from 20th January 1999.

The Greffier of the States was directed to arrange for this Act to be presented to the States for information in due course.”.
