

## Report

On 24th February 2000, the Home Affairs Committee made an Act delegating certain of its functions under the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) (Jersey) Order 1997.

The terms of the delegation were recorded in an Act of the Committee as follows -

“A26. The Committee, in pursuance of Article 36A of the States of Jersey Law 1966, as amended, decided with immediate effect to delegate to the Inspector of Motor Traffic its functions under Article 9A(2) of the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) (Jersey) Order 1997, as follows -

<b>Legislation:</b>	Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) (Jersey) Order 1997, Article 9A(2).
<b>Delegate:</b>	The Inspector of Motor Traffic.
<b>Function delegated:</b>	To approve instructions to conduct compulsory basic training.
<b>Scope of delegation:</b>	To enable trained motorcycle instructors to be approved to conduct Compulsory Basic Training as required by the above Order.

The Greffier of the States was requested to arrange for this Act to be presented to the States for information.”.
