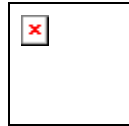

## THE ECOLOGY FUND - 1999

The establishment of the Ecology Fund (P.32/91) required that an annual report be presented to the States. This report details the activities of the fund during the year ending 31st December 1999.

### **The trustees and their meetings**

The trustees, under the chairmanship of Deputy J.T. Johns, met on four occasions during the last year. The trustees, in addition to Deputy J.T. Johns, are Mr. R. Burrow, Mr. C. Le Bail, Mr. H. Forshaw and Mr. R. Long.

### **Projects approved in 1998 and paid for in the current year**

#### Extension to the hydrological survey project St. Ouen's Pond area

An extension to the grant given to The National Trust for Jersey to fund the purchase and installation of water monitoring stations around the St. Ouen's Pond wetland area.

#### Woodland management and path maintenance on the Stafford House Site

A grant was made to The Jersey Association of The Men of The Trees to fund woodland management and path maintenance on the Stafford House site, Grand Vaux.

Grants were made available to the Jersey Cycling Group to fund research into Jersey transport issues and to investigate sustainable options for commuters.
