#### Report

On 12th June 2000, the Public Services Committee made an Act delegating certain of its functions under the Water Pollution (Jersey) Law 2000.

The terms of the delegation were recorded in an Act of the Committee as follows -

"A6. The Committee, in pursuance of Article 36A of the States of Jersey Law 1966, as amended, decided, with immediate effect, to delegate its power under the Water Pollution (Jersey) Law 2000 as follows -

**Legislation:** Water Pollution (Jersey) Law 2000

**Delegate:** Chief Executive Officer; Director of Regulatory

Services; Manager - Water Resources

# **Functions** delegated:

# (1) Article 10 with the exception of (1)(a) and (d))

Publishing of Notices and consultation before considering applications relating to Discharge Permits.

# (2) Article 19(1) (with the exception of reference to Discharge Certificates)

Particular regard to high risk substances when considering applications relating to Discharge Permits.

#### (3) **Article 21**

Consideration of Discharge Permits.

#### (4) **Article 22**

Conditions attached to Discharge Permits.

### (5) Article 23

Procedure for varying or revoking Discharge Permits.

### (6) **Article 24**

Procedure for suspension of Discharge Permits.

### (7) **Article 25**

Consideration of transfer of Discharge Permits.

#### (8) Article 27 (with the exception of (1)(c))

Procedure for notification of decisions relating to Discharge Permits.

#### (9) **Article 34**

Access to documents relevant to Law.

### (10) Article 35

Require information relating to potentially polluting matter.

#### (11) Article 36

Require precautions to be taken to prevent pollution.

#### (12) Article 37

Require polluters to eliminate and

remediate pollution.

# (13) **Article 38**

Procedure to be adopted in respect of Articles 34-37.

# (14) **Article 39(1)**

Enables Committee to undertake remedial action in respect of Articles 36 and 37.

# (15) **Schedule 5**

Transitional provisions in respect of Discharge Permits.

The Greffier of the States was requested to arrange for this Act to be presented to the States for information in due course."
