Welfare Benefit Rates: recommended rates from 1st October 2000

The Employment and Social Security Committee wishes to advise the States that the scale rates of certain welfare benefits are to be increased with effect from 1st October 2000, as shown below.

Members are reminded that the present scale rate of benefit for a dependent relative aged up to 15 (£35.35 a week for each child) took effect from 1st January 2000 to coincide with the timing of the adjustment of the family allowance payments provided by the Employment and Social Security Committee. This rate will be adjusted with effect from the date when family allowance payments are next increased in January 2001.

The personal allowance for those people in residential care is increased to £21.
