THE ECOLOGY FUND - 2000

The establishment of the Ecology Fund (P.32/91) required that an annual report be presented to the States. This report details the activities of the fund during the year ending 31st December 2000.

The trustees and their meetings

The trustees, under the chairmanship of Deputy J. Bridge, met on six occasions during the last year. The trustees, in addition to Deputy J. Bridge, are Mr. R. Burrow, Mr. C. Le Bail, Mr. H. Forshaw and Mr. R. Long.

Aware that the capital sum of the fund is fixed, the trustees have adopted a prudent approach to the award of grants over the last few years, in order to maintain the real value of the fund.

As a result, the trustees are pleased to report that the fund is in a health condition, and would like to take this opportunity to request that any States member who is aware of potentially worthy environmentally based projects encourages members of the public to apply to the fund.
